Sample Itinerary

Day 1	Welcome to Bali	Selamat Pagi! Welcome to Bali! Meet and greet with our guide and transfer to your hotel in Canggu area. Canggu has a beautiful beach to take a walk along and take in the sunset before dinner.
Day 2	White Water Rafting & Sacred Monkey Forest	After breakfast you will be picked up at the hotel, and we will go to the departure point of the rafting. There you get instructions on how to behave on the boat and you will receive a life jacket, paddle and a helmet. We begin then the approximately two hour adventure on the sacred white water river (Ayung), passing villages, beautiful nature and jungle and waterfalls. On the way to hotel you will visit The Monkey Forest, also known as the Sacred Monkey Forest of Padang Tegal. This is one of Ubud's most popular attractions; a natural forest sanctuary that is home to a horde of grey long-tailed macaques! Come face to face with these amazing animals, they may even let you feed them or get that all important Monkey Selfie!
Day 3	Munduk Waterfall & Ulundanu Bratan Temple	Today you will be exploring Bali's hidden treasures forests of central Bali – this one is bound to take your breath away by visiting Munduk Waterfall (or similar, depend on situation on this day). Munduk Waterfall Trekking will lead you to the Bali forest plantation (Coffee, Cacao, Clove) and most magnificent waterfall, a cold breeze from the spring waterfall welcomes you. Don't missed the chance to stop by at the Wanagiri Hidden Hills where the "twin lakes" Buyan and Tamblingan meet in a caldera, formed after a volcanic eruption thousands of years ago, creating a unique naturalistic panorama. On the way back to hotel there will be a stop to Ulundanu Bratan Temple. Lake Beratan is the second largest lake in Bali, and is the source of irrigation for rice fields and plantations across the entire Bedugul Village. The mountain on which it sits is often referred to as "the holy mountain" as the weather is cool and the soil rich and fertile. Atop a plateau that sits on Lake Beratan, stands the majestic Ulun Danu Temple. It was built in adoration of the Goddess Danu and the area surrounding the temple is believed to have been a site of worship and center for religious rituals since the megalithic period.
Day 4	Mount Batur Sunrise Trek	It's trekking time! Mount Batur Sunrise trekking begin in darkness with flashlights that guide provided, the path during hike illuminated by nothing more than your flashlights on the hand. As you reach the summit, the sky turns from black to inky blue to pink and orange. Enjoy the breakfast box and follow with a trek back down the mountain, and then soothe away your aches and pains at a natural hot spring. There are mineral pools with temperatures of up to 40 degrees centigrade, and a lakeside pier where you can take in the majestic beauty of the lake with the peaks of Batur and Abang as backdrop.


Day 5	Balinese Activity Experience at Ruma Desa	Today you will be visiting Rumah Desa, a place where you will get an extraordinary experience. You will also split into several small groups and get to know more about the traditional Balinese architecture, learn daily life of the Balinese people, this may include interacting with locals, observing make offering, make traditional scrub (Boreh) as a preventive treatment. Introduce Balinese alphabets, trekking to the rice field to exploring the traditional Subak irrigation system, learning about the importance of water management in rice fields and its role in Balinese agriculture, ploughing with cows, rice planting, and practice many varieties of traditional games. Don't forget to bring some fresh clothes on your back pack. You will then transfer to your next hotel in Canggu area and it's your free time for rest and relax.
Day 6	Surf School & Capoeira Class	Today, head off to catch some waves in an authentic Indonesian Surf lesson on one of Bali's most beautiful palm fringed beaches! It provides an open, fun, and friendly learning environment for beginners, with a team of experienced instructors who are determined to get you standing on your board within your first few lessons. Continue drive to your next activity, a Capoeira Class. Capoeira is a manifestation of an Afro-Brazilian culture that bears very peculiar features: it is a blend of fight, games and dance executed to the sound of musical instruments, claps and chanting. The Capoeira activity is designed for people to be active and also to be interactive with each other, learn Capoeira in a safe, nurturing and positive environment. The Participants are encouraged to learn and be challenged by the movements, rhythm, or songs, music, passed on to them yet also given the opportunity to develop their own style. This course invites everyone to discover, explore and learn the beauties and mysteries of this Afro Brazilian culture. But most of all, our Capoeira activities are based on having fun, as a mediator for individuals to gather as one healthy community.
Day 7	Turtle Conservation & Farewell Dinner	Today you will be learning and caring for Balinese turtles! All sea turtle species are endangered, mainly due to human activity such as hunting and consumption of eggs, Pollution of the ocean and destruction of breeding beaches has also decreased the turtle population dramatically over the last few years. That's why we're here to help! Continue drive Tanah Lot Temple. Imagine the image of a Balinese temple (pura) perched high on the rock, facing the wide open ocean. With the crashing waves below and the dramatic colors of the dusk sky as background, lit by the slowly disappearing sun.
Day 8	Departure	It's time to say goodbye as you head to the Airport in time for your flight home.
