Day Wise Program

Day 1

Welcome to Tokyo!



- Arrive in the vibrant city of **Tokyo**, a city that perfectly blends culture and advanced technology, and proceed to the hotel for check-in

- Spend some time soaking in the energy of the area, taking photos, and experiencing the famous scramble crossing.

Day 2

Tokyo Disneyland



- This morning get ready and proceed to **Tokyo Disneyland**
- Spend a Full day at **Tokyo Disneyland**

- Start your Disneyland adventure in Fantasyland. Enjoy classic attractions like "It's a Small World," Peter Pan's Flight, and The Haunted Mansion.
- End your magical day by heading back to your hotel. Reflect on the wonderful memories created at Tokyo Disneyland

Day 3

Visit Hakone and Cable car



- This morning pack your bags and proceed to visit Hakone
- Take the **breathtaking views of Mt Fuji** while traveling to Hakone
- Upon reaching Hakone, take the Hakone Cable Car from Hakone-Yumoto Station to Gora Station.
- Enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and lush greenery during the scenic ride.
 (*Note : Cable Car Ride is subject to Weather Conditions)
- Transfer to the Fujisan World Heritage Centre, an interactive visitors centre that features exhibits on the social and environmental history of the areas surrounding Fuji
- Head back to the train station to catch the Shinkansen for your return journey to Tokyo
- Upon returning to Tokyo, freshen up and prepare for the evening's entertainment.
- Head towards the Sumo Museum for the national sport of Sumo Wrestling and see the wrestlers practice while learning about the history of the sport
- Immerse yourself in the traditional sport and witness the impressive displays of strength and skill.
- After the sumo wrestling match, enjoy a hearty dinner at a nearby restaurant.

Day 4 Experience Japanese Culture and history



- Start your day by heading to Asakusa, a historic district in Tokyo known for its traditional atmosphere
- Rent a kimono from one of the many kimono rental shops in the area. Take your time selecting your favorite design and accessories.
- Once dressed in your kimono, explore the streets of Asakusa. Visit Sensoji Temple, Tokyo's oldest temple, and its iconic Kaminarimon Gate
- Participate in a traditional Japanese tea ceremony to immerse yourself in Japanese culture and hospitality.
- Experience Japan's cultural activity, the Tea Ceremony a tradition often practiced for the preparation and presentation of the matcha, a type of green tea very famous in Japan and everywhere in the world
- After the tea ceremony, make your way to team Lab Borderless or team Lab Planets, immersive digital art exhibitions that showcase stunning light displays and interactive installations.

Day 5 Bullet Train to Kyoto



- Pack your bag and embark on an exciting journey to Kyoto
- Enjoy the high-speed bullet train journey through the Japanese countryside, admiring the scenic landscapes along the way.
- Upon arrival in Kyoto, head to your first destination to the Hozugawa River for a boat ride. Experience the Hozugawa River Boat Ride, a serene journey down the picturesque Hozugawa River.
- Enjoy lunch at a riverside restaurant
- After lunch, head to Kanauji Temple, also known as the Golden Pavilion
- Marvel at the stunning architecture of this iconic Zen Buddhist temple, which is covered in gold leaf and surrounded by a tranquil pond and meticulously manicured gardens.
- Continue your cultural exploration with a visit to Nijo Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- In the evening, head to Osaka, which is easily accessible from Kyoto by train.
- Check into your hotel in Osaka and unwind after a day of sightseeing.

Day 6 Universal Studio



- This morning, embark on an adventurous journey to Universal Studio
- Spend the morning and early afternoon exploring the various themed areas and attractions within Universal Studios Osaka.
- Experience thrilling rides such as The Wizarding World of Harry Potter, Jurassic Park, Hollywood Dream - The Ride, and more.
- Enjoy live shows, street entertainment, and character meet-and-greets throughout the park



- Start your day with a delicious breakfast at your hotel
- Explore Osaka Castle, a magnificent historical landmark that stands as a symbol of the city's past
- Make your way to Umeda and visit the Umeda Sky Building, an iconic landmark offering panoramic views of Osaka.
- Take the escalators up to the Floating Garden Observatory, located between the two towers of the building, and enjoy breathtaking views of the city skyline from above.
- Explore the observation deck and learn about the history and architecture of the Umeda Sky Building
- Make your way to Dotonbori, Osaka's bustling entertainment district known for its vibrant atmosphere and iconic neon signs.
- Take a leisurely walk along the Dotonbori Canal, lined with colorful restaurants, shops, and entertainment venues.

- Proceed towards the Osaka Museum of History, located near Osaka Castle. Explore the museum's exhibits, which provide a comprehensive overview of Osaka's rich history and cultural heritage.

- Head toward airports to catch your flight to your home country
- Board your flight and settle in for your journey to Dubai, reminiscing about your time in Osaka and Japan.
